Miracle of Life Brings Joy to CWCF Family

On Sunday, April 17, 2005 little Nathan Blaine Carr was born to Blaine and Rachal Carr, of the Tri-Cities. What everyone expected to be a routine delivery turned dramatically wrong. Only hours old, Nathan (8 lbs. 2 oz. – 21.5 in.) flew by emergency helicopter without mom or dad to Spokane, WA for treatment.

“Nathan was flown to Sacred Heart Medical Center on the night of his birth,” said third-time dad Blaine Carr. “He underwent open heart surgery on April 26th to fix the transposition of his major vessels.”

The following days represent some of the most difficult experienced by the Carr family. With two other small children, Rachal and Blaine divided their time between Ronald McDonald’s House next to the hospital and the Pediatric Intensive Care Unit. An extended support group of family and friends spent days waiting for any news, while only imagining Nathan’s struggle and the anguish gripping his parents.

“Two weeks later we were able to take him home,” said Mr. Carr, with more than just a sense of relief. “He is continuing to recover and is getting stronger each day. We are so grateful for him!”

Nathan’s dad works for Petersen Hastings in Kennewick. You may have noticed that in the last issue of our newsletter we did not have our usual current funds listed.

Besides many other things that Blaine Carr does for the *Central Washington Catholic Foundation*, he is the person who crunches our numbers each quarter.

We, too, celebrate the joy that the Carr family experiences with the birth of their newest child. And besides, the stock and bond markets for the first quarter of this year were not memorable *at all*.

Nathan helped us all realize what is important.
