CWCF Trustees Invite You To Foundation's Celebrations

As the 2006-2007 Chairwoman of the Board of Trustees of the *Central Washington Catholic Foundation*, I invite you to celebrate with us the first Francis Eugene Cardinal George Medallion award given as the highest public recognition for service to the greater Catholic community on Saturday, September 16, 2006.

Bishop William S. Skylstad, the president of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), bishop of the Diocese of Spokane, and former bishop of Yakima, will present this remarkable award. His address and the giving of the very first medallion begin at 1:00 pm at Holy Family Church in Yakima (5315 Tieton Drive). It will be *free* and open to the public. A reception for the recipients will follow the presentation.

Bishop Skylstad has agreed to preside at a liturgy at Holy Family later that same day. The Mass will start at 4:00 pm.

At 6:30 pm, the Foundation's Board of Trustees will sponsor a semiformal dinner at the Yakima Country Club. The menu for this fabulous feast is printed on the inside. Our Board will wine and dine the recipients, Bishop Skylstad, Bishop Carlos A. Sevilla, S.J. and you.

Yes, you, too, can come to this wonderful dining experience. The tickets are \$250 a plate and all proceeds will go to a special fund named after the Cardinal. Your check will serve as your reservation. A few tickets are still available, so do not wait and miss out.

The members of the Board of Trustees are underwriting the Foundation's celebrations and dinner.

The Young Ladies Institute (YLI) and the Knights of Columbus will host the church reception. *No* Foundation money will be used for these events.

La Junta Directiva lo invita a las celebraciones de la Fundación

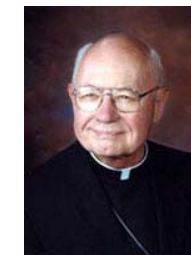

Cardinal George Continues Recovery

Francis Cardinal George, O.M.I., continues to recover from bladder cancer surgery.

The five-hour surgery took place at Loyola University Medical Center in Chicago on July 27, 2006. A spokesperson for Cardinal George stated that the prognosis looked very good. There will be no need for radiation or chemotherapy following surgery.

The Cardinal is the vice-president of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB), the archbishop of Chicago and a former bishop of Yakima.

He was scheduled to present the Foundation's first award. The Francis Eugene Cardinal George Medallion award was named after the Cardinal for his lifetime of service to the greater Catholic community.

Celebrate Joy of Service

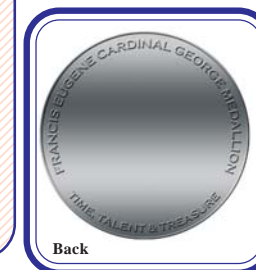
