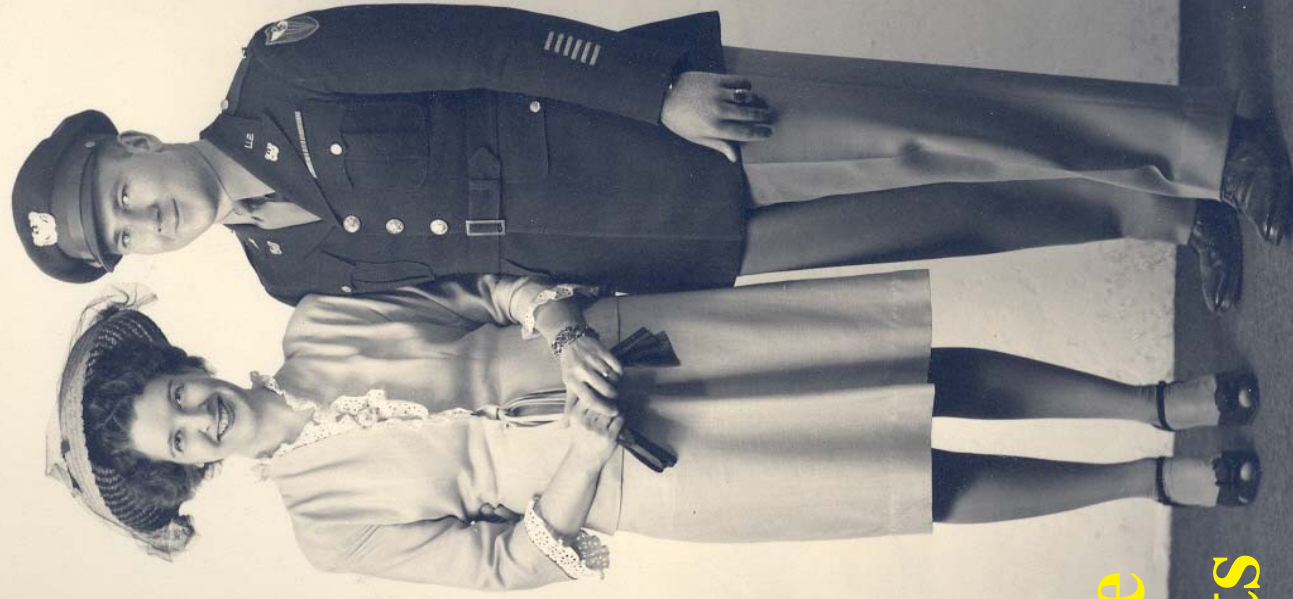

## Foundation Sponsors Cardinal George's Return For Talk, Award, Mass & Dinner

Francis Eugene Cardinal George, the Archbishop of Chicago and former Bishop of Yakima, will return for a special speaking engagement sponsored by the *Central Washington Catholic Foundation* on Saturday, September 16, 2006.

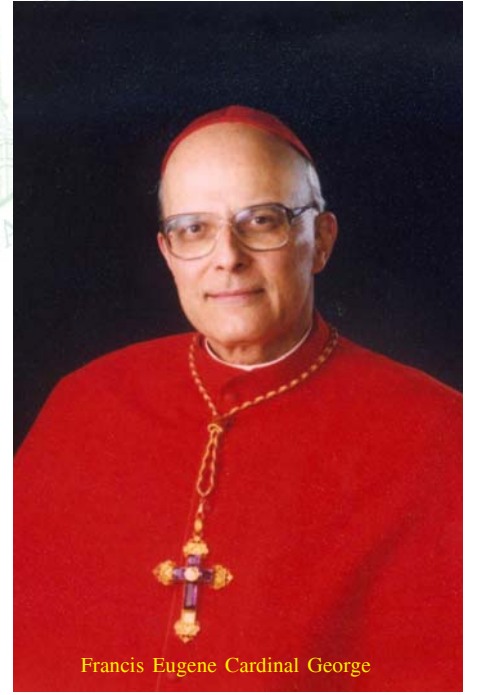
In connection with the presentation of the first Francis Eugene Cardinal George Medallion award, the Cardinal will speak at 1:30 pm at Holy Family Church in Yakima, WA. A reception will follow the Cardinal's address and the awarding of the medallion in the parish's gathering hall. These events are free and open to the public. Cardinal George will also officiate at a Mass at 4:00 pm.

A private dinner will be held at the Yakima Country Club later that evening. Tickets for the dinner will be \$250 a plate and all proceeds will go to a special fund named after the Cardinal. Dinner tickets are on sale and your check will

serve as your reservation. There are only 194 tickets available for the dinner. These tickets will go fast, so please plan appropriately.

The members of the Board of Trustees are underwriting the Cardinal events and dinner. The Young Ladies Institute (YLI) and the Knights of Columbus will host the church reception. *No* Foundation money will be used for these events.

# Local Couple's Act of Love Continues Forever

In the uncertain days of 1942, a petite attractive young Irish lass moved to Seattle, WA after attending the University of Montana. A vicious war had engulfed the world. Yet, while fighting for freedom off Alaska's coastal waters, a tall young Army Air Corps Officer met and fell in love with this remarkable woman.

Sounds like the synopsis of a movie starring Maureen O'Hara and John Wayne. Unlike the two characters from the silver screen, these people really did meet and fall in love during the struggles of World War II.

Mary McLaughlin was born and raised in Anaconda, MT. Her mother was a telegraph operator before marrying her mining engineer husband who helped develop the copper industry in Montana.

William A. Hambelton was born in Tieton, WA to a family whose roots go back to the pioneers who settled Central Washington.

Bill and Mary Hambelton married at the Emergency Rescue Boat Station in Avila, CA in 1945. Bill continued in the Air Force until 1964 when the family moved back to Central Washington. Mary died in 2005 of Alzheimer's after celebrating their 60<sup>th</sup> wedding anniversary.

Before Mary's death at 86, the Hambelton's set up a perpetual fund with the *Central Washington Catholic Foundation* to benefit Catholic college students at Yakima Valley Community College.

In a very real way, their love for each other and their desire to help educate Catholics in Central Washington will live through the William A. and Mary M. Hambelton Educational Fund.
